## **Dean T. Langford abbreviated biography**

Dean Langford was President and CEO of Sylvania and Osram Sylvania for over seventeen years until retiring in 2001 as the lighting company's longest-standing chief executive. Following his retirement, he remained on the Board of Directors Prior to his appointment to President of Sylvania, he was Vice President of Marketing for GTE Diversified Products and Services for two years following nineteen years with IBM Corporation where he held several key executive positions.

He has been a member of the Board of Directors of the Alliance To Save Energy for twelve years and served as the first non-congressional co-chairman for eight years. The Alliance was founded during the energy crisis twenty-seven years ago by Senators Charles Percy and Hubert Humphrey to help insure our global competitiveness and to lead our national effort toward a clean environment. In 2003 Gail Norton, Secretary of Interior, appointed him to a six-year term on the Board of Directors of the National Park Foundation of the United States of America.

Mr. Langford has served on a number of boards in the private and public sector including the National Manufacturers Association, the National Electrical Manufacturers Association, The Boston-area North Shore Chamber Of Commerce and Vision 2000, an education initiative of the Society of Automotive Engineers. Dean is a graduate of the University of Illinois with a B.S. in mathematics and holds an honorary Doctor of Humane Letters degree from Salem (Mass.) State College.

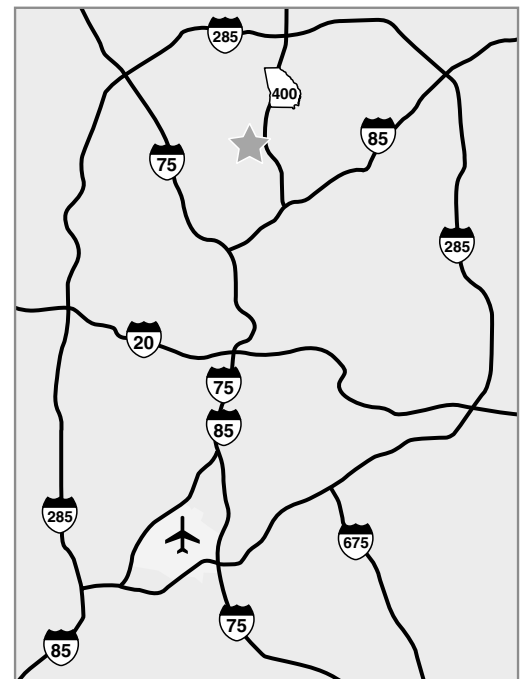
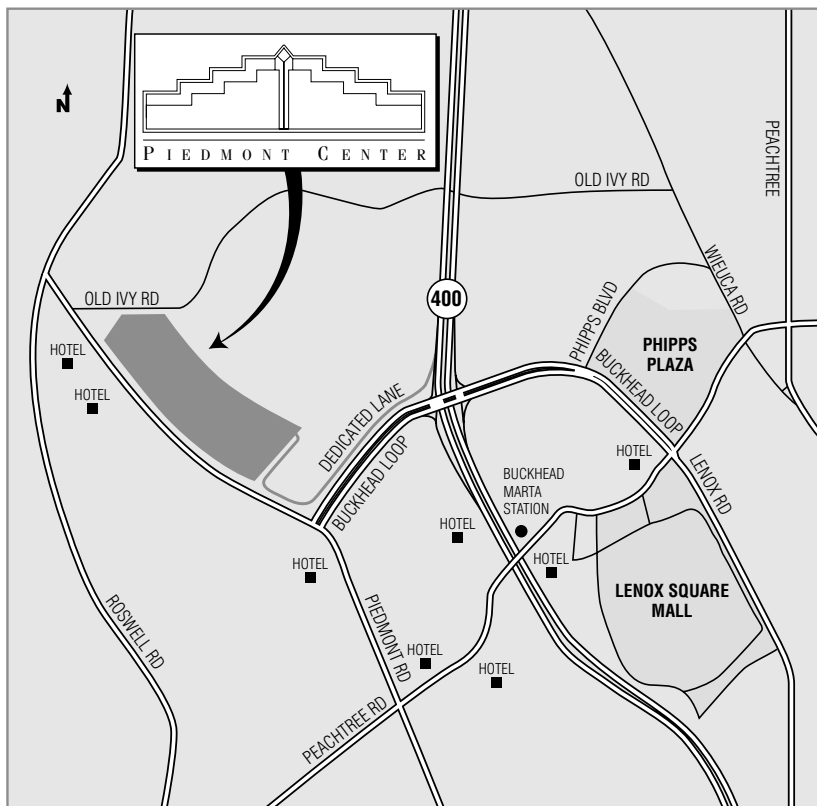
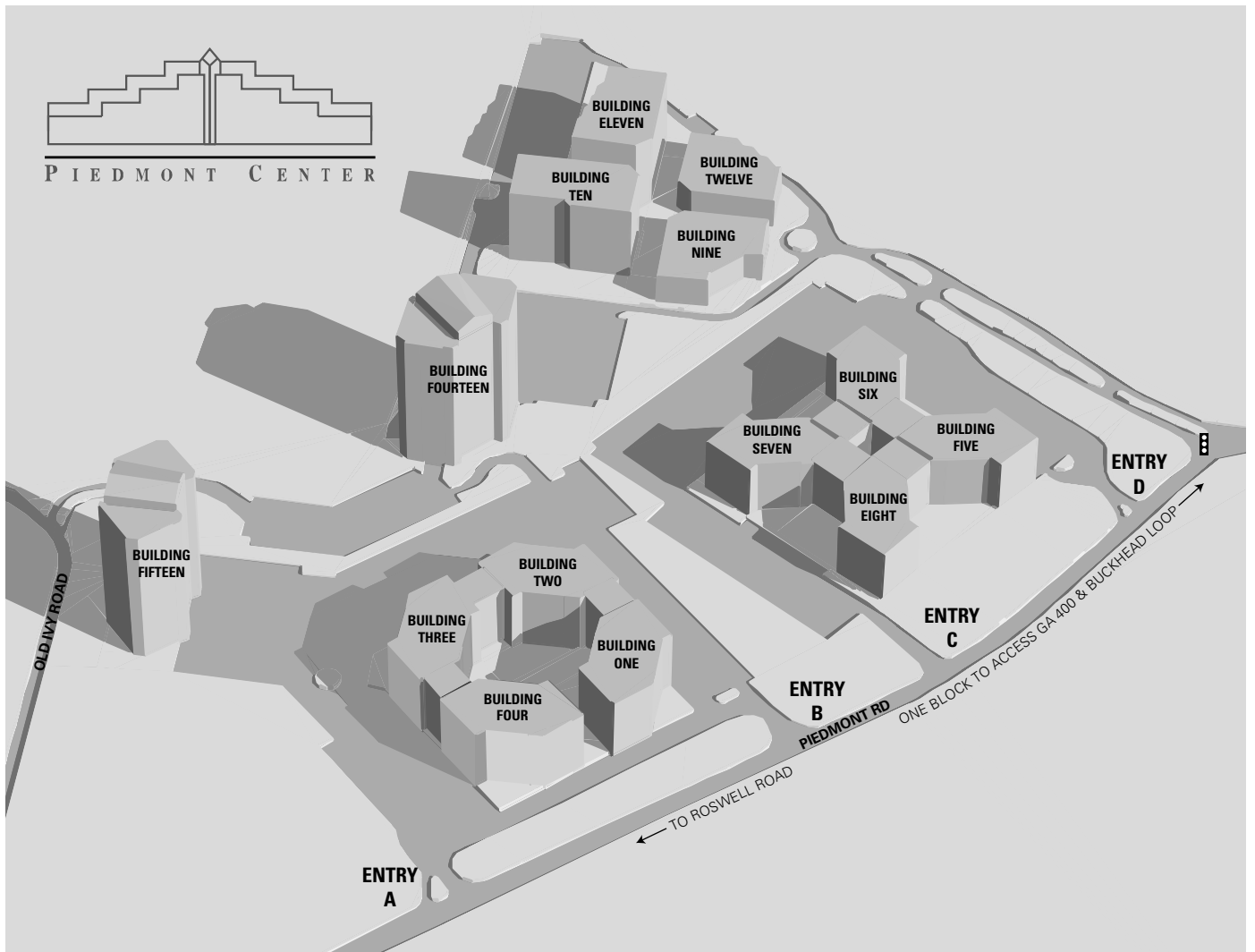
