■ FEBRUARY MEETING DETAIL ■

What: Daylighting as an Art Form

Daylighting as a technical challenge has been "solved". Analytical capabilities, perimeter and core architectural strategies, daylight harvesting and lighting control technologies are in place. But the unthinking substitution of a photon of daylight for a photon of electric light ignores the powerful articulating and animating role daylight has played in Architecture for millennia. Mr. Norris will discuss projects ranging from churches to schools to offices that use advanced optics and reflection of sunlight to create playful and surprising effects. He will also discuss how daylighting can play an equally important role in the development of sustainable urban plans that balance the need for both the private and public light. These should help stimulate a broad conversation about how designing with daylight can become both a green efficiency strategy and an art form."
